 - Respeto a los compañeros.
 - Colaboración y cooperación.
 - Normas internas de conducta.
- APTITUD: puntuación máxima 5 puntos y hace referencia a:
 - Pruebas físicas en función de lo visto en cada evaluación.
 - Cuaderno diario de clase.
 - Trabajos por escrito que se deben entregar en el cuaderno de clase.
 - Exámenes orales o escritos sobre lo visto y dicho en clase o de los trabajos pedidos.
